The Nuffield Foundation is looking for employers to provide opportunities for talented 17-year-old students to work on a short research and development project for four to six weeks in their summer holidays.

Projects must have broadly scientific or technical content, but they don't have to be based in a laboratory. They might be office-based or include a lot of fieldwork, or they might focus on engineering, data analysis or computer science.

One of the programme's main goals is to widen participation in STEM and quantitative social science careers and to increase social mobility, making it an ideal programme for fulfilment of your public engagement, widening participation or corporate social responsibility goals.
